Information for Authors

Manuscripts of papers for submission should be sent, in English, as an attachment to an email or a hard copy printout, to one of the editors:

The author should retain a copy of the paper; the editors cannot accept responsibility for the return of submissions.

Authors should send a $\text{T}_{\text{E}}\text{X}$ or $\text{L}^{\text{A}}\text{T}_{\text{E}}\text{X}$ file of the final accepted version of their manuscripts as an attachment to an email. The authors should also send a hard copy printout of the final accepted version.

If the authors follow the style below and produce their papers in $\text{T}_{\text{E}}\text{X}$ or $\text{L}^{\text{A}}\text{T}_{\text{E}}\text{X}$, it should be possible to print directly from the manuscript or to construct our version by modifying their files. This reduces both costs and the probability of introducing errors at our end.

1. Papers should be prepared in one of the various flavours of $\text{T}_{\text{E}}\text{X}$ (we use $\text{L}^{\text{A}}\text{T}_{\text{E}}\text{X}$).
2. The page size should be 13.4 by 21.8 cm (5.28 by 8.58 inches) in 12 point.
3. A short abstract should be included. This should stand alone, independent of the references.
4. References should be numbered in alphabetical order and referred to by number. For example, "...Donovan [7] showed that..."

In the references:

[7] Diane Donovan, *The Completion of Partial Latin Squares*, Australasian Journal of Combinatorics, **22** (2000), 247–264.

Author's name should NOT be inverted in reference list: write D. Donovan, *not* Donovan, D.

5. Pictures should be sent in encapsulated postscript files (.eps files) as attachments to an email.
6. The author's address should follow the author's name, and should be a usable postal address.
